

Payer Agreements

SCOTT & WHITE HEALTH PLAN

Pediatric Partners members have access to a value-based contract with the Scott & White Health Plan (SWHP). This contract includes the following health plans in the Dallas market:

- Scott & White: Commercial HMO
- Scott & White: POS
- Scott & White: Commercial PPO

This agreement demonstrates the shift from a volume-based model to a value-based model. Our members benefit from a fee schedule for health care services, including the opportunity to earn pay-for-quality incentives based on achieving defined health outcome goals.

CIGNA COLLABORATIVE ACCOUNTABLE CARE (CAC)

Pediatric Partners members have access to this value-based agreement with no financial downside risk. Pediatricians with underlying Cigna Participation Agreements are eligible to participate, and this CAC Program is separate from a physician's existing Cigna fee schedule.

The Cigna CAC is a value-based program that provides financial incentives for care coordination with the shared goal of improving clinical results and managing overall health care spend. Pediatric Partners leadership receives routine finance reports to help achieve this goal. The Pediatric Partners' care coordination team has access to meaningful health care reports that give insight into patients' care outside of our physicians' offices. This enables active intervention and collaboration for better care. The care coordinators manage these reports, contact patients, and engage our physicians to drive improved health outcomes and reduction in unnecessary costs.

AMERIGROUP PROVIDER QUALITY INCENTIVE PROGRAM (PQIP)

Pediatric Partners primary care providers (PCPs) have access to this value-based agreement with no financial downside risk. To participate, physicians must have an underlying Amerigroup Participation Agreement, be in good standing, and have an open panel for Amerigroup patients.

PQIP is an incentive program intended to reward PCPs for quality care with the shared goal of improving clinical results, promoting efficient utilization of health care services, and managing health care cost. Our providers have access to health care data through Amerigroup's portal, Provider Care Management Solutions (PCMS). The PCMS portal allows providers to review their current and newly assigned patients, care opportunities, preventable ED visits, pharmacy utilization analysis, and more.

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BAYLOR SCOTT & WHITE QUALITY ALLIANCE (BSWQA)

In continuing to expand member resources and capabilities, Pediatric Partners participates in the Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance, which allows members who opt-in to be Tier One providers for employers that have selected to participate in this accountable care organization (ACO), either through their payer or directly with BSWQA. The members in an ACO arrangement are attributed to primary care providers based on preponderance of care. There are 42,000 pediatric lives attributed to Pediatric Partners members participating in the BSWQA contract as of January 2018.

This opportunity, created through our partnership with the Pediatric Alliance, an affiliate of Children's Health, allows for:

- Claims data sharing and analytics of the patient population
- An opportunity to extend care management services to your high-risk patients attributed to BSWQA
- A potential to earn shared savings payments

With this business development, Pediatric Partners has realized the true advantages of becoming a clinically integrated network. The employer groups that have elected to participate in the BSWQA ACO are associated with the following health plans and third-party administrators:

CHILDREN'S HEALTH EMPLOYEE BENEFIT PLAN
